

Beat the summer itch

Skin problems often peak during the summer, with the warmer weather and an increase in irritating pollens and pesky parasites having a part to play.

Here are some of the key summer skin issues and tips to combat them:

Pollen or grass allergies:

Like many humans, pets can have sensitivities and allergies to their natural environment. When trying to locate what's causing your pet to feel excessively itchy, keep your eyes peeled for helpful clues and if they are particularly itchy after they've come into contact with something specific like grass, which could signal a grass allergy.

Hot spots and infections:

The warmer, more humid weather can increase the risk of skin infections – especially in dogs with a dense coat, skin folds or those who suffer from allergies. Herbal support can help soothe the itchiness, with regular grooming helping to remove moulted coat.

Parasites:

Fleas, ticks and flies can all become more of a nuisance in the summer months. As well as treating your pet if they do have a problem, ensuring your home is treated too can be a very important part of the process. This will help to eradicate parasites and stop the cycle from reoccurring.

Grass seeds:

Grass seeds can be a nightmare if they penetrate your dog's skin, feet and ears, with skin folds also a common place to find them, so make sure you check your dog after every walk.

Sunburn:

If your pet has a thin coat or little pigment, they may be at risk of sunburn. Always make sure they have access to shade and apply a pet-safe suncream as needed to high-risk areas.

Amelia's tips to keep cool this summer

Our resident partner VSA Certified Professional Dog Trainer & Behavioural Specialist Amelia Steele gives her advice for keeping your dog comfortable with rising temperatures this summer, and how to support seasonal allergies.

"As temperature starts to rise, it's important to keep an eye on your dog. Not only might they feel generally more uncomfortable, it's also important to know when it is and isn't safe to go on walks. Here are my top tips for keeping your dog comfortable throughout the summer:

1. Help keep your dog cool

"To help keep your dog cool, you can purchase products like cooling mats & bandanas. Personally, I prefer the bandanas as mats can get ripped up! It can also help to orient your enrichment around cooling activities. This could range from a paddling pool to splash around in, to making frozen lick mats or Kongs for your dog.

2. Limit or change walks

"When temperatures start to rise it's worth being cautious when it comes to walks, especially for dogs who are larger, older or overweight. Stick to slow lead walks and end walks quickly if your dog shows any signs of discomfort such as: heavy panting, drooling or generally struggling. Avoid games like fetch or any vigorous exercise. Try to walk your dog early in the morning or late at night when it's cool. After 26 degrees, I typically recommend avoiding prolonged time outside all together.

3. Prepare your dog for more distractions

"Another common issue I see in the summer is an increase in reactivity. With the weather improving, usual walking routes will get busier. This means dogs have to put up with a lot more exposure to other dogs and people compared to the winter months. This can lead to both excitement or fear reactivity depending on your dog. To avoid this, I recommend spending some time proactively desensitising your dog and building up to all these new distractions.

4. Use herbal support for summer allergies

"Allergies are a common trigger for behavioural change. If you see signs your dog is getting itchy and uncomfortable, you may start to see an increase in "naughty" behaviour. Dorwest's **Garlic & Fenugreek Tablets** and **Green Releaf® Tablets** work really well together to help boost immunity and soothe itchy skin, so I'd definitely recommend herbal support for allergy symptoms. Try to also keep your dog out of long grassy areas, as grass seed and the grass itself can irritate your dog's skin.

"The summer months can pose new challenges for us pet parents, but the key to keeping your dog happy and safe is to be prepared. Getting ahead of any issues that may develop is always the best route, and if in doubt, always do your research to keep your dog safe."

Keeping hormones balanced is vital for your dog's health and well-being, especially true for your pet's sex hormones - oestrogen, progesterone and testosterone - which are more relevant to entire/un-neutered animals.

For bitches, hormone levels naturally fluctuate, leading to physical and behavioural changes especially during seasons, pregnancy and lactation. During these times, extra support can help to maintain optimum balance and promote good fertility. Evening Primrose Oil is renowned for its ability to help maintain normal hormone levels, and Wheatgerm Oil is naturally high in Vitamin E, helping to support hormonal stability and the reproductive system. Homoeopathic remedies can also support pregnancy and whelping, with Caulophyllum 30C to support normal contractions and Urtica Urens **30C** which can help to increase milk flow in lactating females.

Some bitches may experience false, pseudo or phantom pregnancy, which is linked to hormone imbalance following her season. Unfortunately, if your dog has a tendency to these, she's likely to suffer repeatedly, with symptoms of increasing severity. Herbal support can help to reduce the effects including Raspberry Leaf Tablets, often used to help pets better cope with the hormonal changes that can lead to pseudo-pregnancies and can also be used to support pregnancy and birth. Homeoepathic remedy Pulsatilla 15C is useful for maintaining hormonal health following a pseudo-pregnancy, and Urtica Urens 3C is ideal for the mum after a litter as it helps to support the natural bodily process of less milk production, or during a phantom to also reduce milk flow.

For boys, high testosterone levels can bring some unwanted effects such as aggression, dominant behaviour and increased sex drive. **Gelsemium 30C** can help to reduce sex drive, and is ideal for use if a female in season nearby is causing over excitement. **Scullcap & Valerian Tablets** can also help to naturally relax your pet, with the active herbs naturally supporting the calming pathways within the nervous system, reducing anxiety without immobilising muscles or causing drowsiness.

Hormonal balance is key

Mistletoe's journey

Every year 10% of profit from our bestselling Keeper's Mix® range is donated to the Dorwest Foundation, and we were recently able to support rescue and rehoming charity Galgos Del Sol.

The Dorwest Foundation was established as part of our 70th birthday and to show our commitment to ongoing charitable giving 'to help dogs and cats that are in need of care, health and quality of life improvements and to support charities where dogs are trained to help humans either in an assistance, rescue or medical capacity.' At the end of 2023 we funded rescue Galgo Mistletoe's recovery at Galgos del Sol, a licenced charity in both Spain and the UK, rescuing and looking after hundreds of dogs every year. Founder and president Tina Solera moved to Murcia in Spain from the UK in 2007 with her family and now rescues, cares for and rehomes Galgos, Podencos and mixes of those breeds; with her centre housing over 300 dogs at one time.

Sweet 3-year-old Mistletoe was picked up by the Perrera in Almeria, Spain, at the side of the road after being run over and left with an open fracture. She had her leg splinted and strapped at a local vets before going to Galgos Del Sol in Murcia to have an operation to restructure her whole leg. 

You can now recycle our tablet pots through your every week domestic recycling collection, and they can also be recycled several times with stable quality! To make sure that we are doing all that we can to reduce our environmental impact, we're constantly upgrading our green credentials with changes across the entire business.

We are now proud to say that our **delivery packaging is 100% plastic free**. This has included switching to loose-fill packaging that is made from corn starch rather than polystyrene, and using bubble wrap that is fully biodegradable.

Whenever possible though, we prefer to **use shredded carboard**, which is created from waste cardboard collected from all areas of the business. If a box needs filling up to protect our products during transit, we use 100% recycled packing paper and boxes are closed up with paper tape, rather than plastic.

In addition to the delivery packaging changes, all of our **mailing wrappers and carrier bags are fully compostable**. At this rate, our customers will have enough beautiful compost to grow plenty of their own herbs (although maybe just for cooking – leave the supplements to us!)

We've also changed our tablet pots this year to be bio-plastic, made from renewable plant-based resources such as sugar cane or corn or other biological resources, providing a more sustainable alternative to raw materials derived from petroleum, still be classified as food grade. These provide the same shelf life and longevity for quality products.




